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## A CULTURED CHOICE

Cultured marble is a contemporary version of classic stone. It is made of crushed natural marble and pigments, mixed with tough polyester resins it is smoothly molded into bathroom fixtures, tiles and accessories. (Cultured onyx, a related material, incorporates translucent particles such as glass or alumina trihydrate.) Cultured marble evokes the quarried stone's beauty at a much lower cost and comes in a wide spectrum of consistent colors.

## INSTALLATION

1. Prior to installation of your new vanity top, inspect it thoroughly for cosmetic defects. If you find cosmetic defects, notify your dealer immediately and do not install your top as most warranties do not cover installation.
2. To install your top, first make a trial fit. If top does not seat, the backsplash and wall ends may be shaved using a belt sander or cut using a masonry wheel or you may scribe the top to the wall surface.
3. After trial fit, remove the top from the vanity or frame and install the drain and faucets according to manufacturer's direction. Installing fittings prior to setting the top is much easier and saves time.

**NOTE: Do not tighten fittings more than 1 turn past finger tight.**

4. Apply an L-shaped 2" bead of silicone caulk to each inside corner of each vanity component.
5. Apply a single bead of adhesive to the middle of the backsplash beginning and ending 1" from each end.
6. Set top in desired position on vanity of frame and apply pressure down and toward walls to seat top.
7. Seal all wall joints with silicone caulk. Wipe off all excess caulk and adhesive immediately. Connect drain and water supply lines.
8. Protect the lavatory with a soft cloth during construction. The flat surface is an inviting place for even the most careful tradesman to place tools.



## CARE & MAINTENANCE

The high gloss finish on your new Roman Marble top is a super-hard stain resistant material which, if properly cared for, will provide a lifetime of beauty and service.

To clean your top, you need only use liquid, non-abrasive cleaners. **DO NOT USE ABRASIVES** as prolonged use may result in a dulling of the surface gloss. Here are a few we recommend:

Curling iron supports can scratch or put small dents in the surface. Be sure the protective pads are in place.

Cigarette stains and minor scratches may be removed by buffing the area with auto buffing compound or light wet sanding with 1,500 grit wet sandpaper followed by buffing with auto buffing compound.

Rust stains and lime deposits may be removed with a tub and sink naval type jelly.

A vase or other objects left on a lavatory can yellow the surface beneath it. The discoloration will disappear over time.
